§ 177-1. **Title.**

This chapter shall be known as the "Sign Cleanup Ordinance."

§ 177-2. **Definitions.**

As used in this chapter, the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

SIGNS — All political posters and/or any other sign posted to advertise events being held.

§ 177-3. **Cleanup practices.**

All signs shall be picked up no later than five days after election day and/or of event date held. No sign will be posted on township road signs at any time.

**§ 177-4. Violations and penalties.<sup>1</sup> [Amended 1-22-1997 by Ord. No. 265]**

- A. Any person or group who shall violate any part of this chapter shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$600 or, in default of payment of such fines, then to imprisonment for not more than 30 days.
- B. Each days' continuance of a violation of this chapter may constitute a separate and distinct offense and shall be subject to separate and distinct penalties therefore.
